BAND REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for travel and prize money, **all bands must appear in both** a March Past on Saturday at Noon, **and** at the Massed Bands on Sunday (at approximately 3:00 PM). Band participation at the 5:00 PM Tattoo would also be appreciated.

PIPING, DRUMMING & BAND COMPETITION RULES

1. NO PERSON MAY COMPETE UNLESS S/HE IS IN APPROPRIATE HIGHLAND DRESS (i.e., HAT, TIE, JACKET OPTIONAL (WEATHER PERMITTING)), EXCEPTION: THOSE ENTERED IN GRADE V SOLO COMPETITION.
2. A COMPETITOR MUST BE READY, WHEN CALLED, TO COMPETE OR S/HE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
3. DECISIONS BY JUDGES AND STEWARDS WILL BE FINAL.
4. ALL PIPING, DRUMMING AND BAND CONTESTS WILL BE CONDUCTED UNDER THE RULES OF THE EASTERN UNITED STATES PIPE BAND ASSOCIATION. THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DISQUALIFY ANY COMPETITOR GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT.
5. EACH SNARE DRUMMING COMPETITOR MUST FURNISH HIS/HER OWN ACCOMPANIST. EACH TENOR OR BASS COMPETITOR MAY ONLY HAVE A MAXIMUM OF TWO PIPERS AND ONE SNARE DRUMMER.
6. 1ST PLACE WILL NOT BE AWARDED IN AN OPEN EVENT IF THERE ARE LESS THAN THREE (3) COMPETITORS.
7. BAND DRAWS ARE HELD AT 10 AM EACH DAY IN THE PIPING & DRUMMING REGISTRATION TENT.
8. ENTRY DEADLINE IS NOVEMBER 1, 2010. *NO FIELD ENTRIES. \$30 LATE FEE.* PIPING , DRUMMING AND BAND ENTRIES ARE TO BE SENT TO Rose Adams.
9. ORDER OF PLAY FOR SOLO EVENTS WILL BE POSTED AT THE PIPING & DRUMMING TENT. CHECK IN WITH THE STEWARD BEFORE YOUR EVENT.
10. TRAVEL ALLOWANCE IS \$300 FOR THE 1ST FIVE Texas bands. The 1st out of state band receives \$750. To be determined by post marked.
